On the job, you will:

- Assist in the treatment of sick or injured animals under the supervision of a professional, offering compassionate care and maintaining detailed health records.
- Help design and maintain safe, enriching environments for different animal species to promote their well-being and natural behaviors.
- Engage with the public during educational programs and tours, explaining animal behaviors, dietary needs, and conservation efforts.

Key Attributes

- A keen interest in animal behavior and welfare.
- Strong observational skills to notice changes in animal behavior or health.
- Patience and dedication.

- Problem-solving to address immediate animal care challenges.
