Dispensing Optician

What You Need to Know

Dispensing Opticians design, measure, fit, and adapt lenses and frames for client according to written optical prescription or specification.

Dispensing Opticians assist clients with selecting frames, measuring customers for eyeglasses and coordinating frames with facial and eye measurements and optical prescriptions. They prepare work orders for optical laboratories containing instructions for grinding and mounting lenses in frames. Dispensing Opticians verify finished spectacles and djust frame and lens position to fit clients.

On the job, you will:

- Measure clients' bridge and eye size, temple length, vertex distance, pupillary distance, and optical centers of eyes, using measuring devices.
- Verify that finished lenses are ground to specifications.
- Evaluate prescriptions in conjunction with clients' vocational and avocational visual requirements.
