What You Need to Know

A Pharmacy Technician collects, inputs, and verifies prescriptions, refills, and patient information. Pharmacy Technicians assists a registered pharmacist with support activities and processes required to dispense medical prescriptions. A Pharmacy Technician may prepare labels and routine prepacked orders.

In addition, Certified Pharmacy Technician may be expected to perform some clerical duties, reporting to a supervisor or manager.

On the job, you will:

- Receive written prescription or refill requests and verify that information is complete and accurate.
- Enter prescription information into computer databases.
- Establish or maintain patient profiles, including lists of medications taken by individual patients.
